

COMPETITION DANCESCREEN 2010 AT CINEDANS

At this year's Cinedans Festival the competition, panels and video library will be held in co-operation with dancescreen 2010, the twelfth edition of the international dance film and video competition and festival founded by the IMZ - International Music + Media Centre. We are happy to announce that more than 250 inspiring films have been entered. Cinedans and dancescreen 2010 have selected the most interesting ones for the festival and the competition, but all the entered films will be shown in the video library (see below). The competition contains the Dioraphte Cinedans Jury Award (worth €7.500) and the Dioraphte Encouragement Award (worth €2.000). Besides that, all visitors of the Cinedans Festival could vote for their favorite film (except the ones 'outside the competition') for the Audience Award.

The competition is divided into four categories:

- A) Live Performance Relay multi-camera relay of a live dance performance
- B) Camera Re-work adaptation of an existing choreography
- C) Screen Choreography television/film/data productions with a choreography specifically created for the screen, movement based video clips, experimental films, animation & fiction (C1) not longer than five minutes, C2) not longer than fifteen minutes, C3) over fifteen minutes)
- D) Documentary profile of e.g. a choreographer, dance company or dance history

Throughout the film they offer up their pas de deux of shared days of glory, humorous anecdotes, shining hours, and tragic reversals of fortune. Demikovsky casts Briansky and Briane as narrators of their own life stories. The dance footage from the 1950s and 1960s weaves into the narrative, providing a striking contrast between the couple's past and present. Ballet class piano music (by Orchestra Flora Abramian - VS) plays throughout the film.

Cinedans presents the world premiere of Darkling, a haunting real time duet for body and technology created by choreographer/ director Hélène Lesterlin, interactive software engineer Freider Weiss and composer Stephan Moore. Darkling is a sonic and visual passage through the imaginative landscape of the medieval mind. Starting from fables passed through the ages, sprinkled with rumors of love and sea monsters, magic and ghosts, steeped in superstition and poetry. Darkling exists somewhere between solo performance, interactive digital technology and multichannel radio play. In a nether region of semi-darkness, the audience sits on three sides of an intimate play space that contains dim, flickering particles of light generated by the movement of one mysterious creature. All are enveloped by a living sonic environment of disembodied voices, music, stories and moving sound. Like Frieder Weiss' previous performance Glow (which was a huge success during the 2009 Moving Media evening at Cinedans) projections react to the dancer's moving body.




